Contest Rules

1. The entry fee is a **\$25 tax deductible donation** to The Arc of Calhoun and Cleburne Counties.
2. Performance acts may include performers and stage crew.
3. Each act should prepare two songs for performance. They will be presented in a two-act format, with one song performed in "Round One " of Act I and the second song presented in "Round Two" of Act II following a ten minute intermission.
4. Song choices must be submitted with entry; to avoid duplication, the songs will be approved by the order of submission to The Arc Acts will be notified how to submit their music for the event.
5. This is a family activity... **no** profanity or explicit lyrics will be permitted.
6. Acts will have a **total of 5 minutes** per performance onstage (*including setup, performance and cleanup*).
7. One trophy will be awarded to the winner(s) of each category. All acts will be eligible for competition for the following three awards (tie breakers have been pre-determined for each category).

Judges' Award: Based on an act's originality and creativity, stage presence and lip-synching ability.

In case of a tie, contestants will be asked to perform one number again for judges consideration.

Audience Favorite Award: To be determined by the number of \$1 tickets cast on behalf of each act (tickets will be purchased at the event)

In case of a tie, the audience will be polled.

Put Your Money Where Your Mouth Is Award: Given to the act which raises the most money for The Arc. This amount will be determined by the total of donations and/or event sponsorships raised on behalf of The Arc prior to the evening's contest. The act's entry fee will also be included in this amount. Funds for eligibility for this award should be turned into The Arc by 6 p.m. the night of the competition.

In case of a tie, the total of \$1 tickets for each act from the audience vote will be considered.

8. Each act will be responsible for the music/costumes/props used during their performance.
9. All acts need to be checked-in at the JSU McClellan Theatre no later than 6 p.m. on August 19.
